# PENSION BALLOT – VOTE YES

Teachers have been given a two year pay freeze – now they want you to pay more for your pension. £50 a month more on average for NQT and £100+ for UPS3 teacher.

If you vote YES for strike action you will lose around £65.

If you vote NO or DO NOT VOTE you will lose at least that EVERY MONTH

These Suffolk teachers went on the NUT Pensions calculator and found that:

Linda will pay £66 a month more and lose £62,000

Kate will pay £61 a month more and lose £247,000

Clare will pay £80 a month more and lose £87,925

Neil will pay £96 a month more and lose £80,000
